


Geographic Location of Complaints

The City of Worcester is divided into 20 patrol routes. RT.'s 3, 5, & 12 had the most complaints.




Rt. 5 – 13 Complaints (This number is high due to the complaints occurring at Worcester Police HQ)

RT 3 - 4 Complaints


