## NARRATIVE FOR SERGEANT RODERICK D AMBROSE

Ref: 98-550-AR

SUMMARY REPORT - THIS REPORT MAY OR MAY NOT CONTAIN ALL INFORMATION KNOWN TO POLICE.

On 10/27/98, at about 1003 AM, I received a telephone call from one, Michael Hyde. He wished to pursue a formal complaint against four Abington Police Officers who were involved in a motor vehicle stop of Mr. Hyde and another occupant of his car, on the night before, on Groveland St. and the car entered the lot of Auto Country.

Mr. Hyde told me he was stopped for having long hair and his friend had on a leather jacket.

I informed Chief Franey of the complaint and he assigned the internal investigation to me.

I asked Mr. Hyde if he could come to the station, in person, for the formal complaint. He said because of his work he would be unable to come in until 10/31/98. He said he would bring an audiotape of the stop because he was called an asshole and someone mentioned "blow", (which Mr. Hyde referred to as cocaine).

Mr. Hyde came to the station on Sunday, 11/01/98, and told me his story of the incident about how he believed he was treated unfairly. He told me his passenger was a Daniel ?, (Hardisty?), who never filed a complaint with this police department.

I asked Mr. Hyde if he could provide me with the audiotape, or a copy, which he did. We went to his car's audiocassette player and listened and I could here voices of Abington Officers Force, Aziz, Gambino, and Marquardt. They were recorded without their permission, and the recording was done secretly. It was scratchy and sounded as if it was interrupted, and possibly edited.

Mr. Hyde was asked to provide me with a written statement by 11/06/98. He never provided that statement. He also told me he had a videotape of the incident. I was never provided with that either.

The internal investigation was terminated on 11/15/98, due to the lack of Mr. Hyde providing me with pertinent information and failing to provide his witness information. Also, according to the tape, I submit there was no evidence of any nature that would show problems with the officers based on this specific incident. I spoke to the officers about this complaint, and all seemed to fall in order.

The reason Mr. Hyde was stopped was because his number plate was not illuminated and his exhaust was extremely loud, (harsh and objectionable noise). The exhaust was on a Porsche European Edition high output vehicle, according to Mr. Hyde. The audiocassette has been held as evidence.
