On December 12, 2021 I, Detective James Flynn was assigned as unit 752 of the Woburn Police Criminal Investigation Bureau. On this date I was contacted by Detective Lt. Brian McManus and requested to respond to the Woburn Police Station. Upon arrival at the police station I met with Det Lt. McManus. I followed Det Lt. McManus who transported [REDACTED] to the Winchester Police Department. [REDACTED] is the estranged wife of Woburn Police Officer Tomas Morales.

Upon arrival at the Winchester Police Department I introduced myself to [REDACTED]. I immediately observed bruising on [REDACTED] face and her eyes were red from crying. I asked [REDACTED] if she was in need of any medical attention. [REDACTED] refused medical attention. [REDACTED] and I went to an interview room at the Winchester Police Station. While in the interview I observed marks on [REDACTED]'s neck consistent with having been strangled.

[REDACTED] reported that today around 11:45 hours she ran into [REDACTED] at the end of their son, [REDACTED] basketball game at the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he was going to come by the house at [REDACTED] where [REDACTED] and the children are currently living. [REDACTED] reported she was alright with this as she thought he wanted to discuss Christmas for the kids. [REDACTED] reported she went to pick up her dogs and then went home.

[REDACTED] reported Mr. Morales was near the back of the house and asked Michelle if he could talk with her for a moment. [REDACTED] reported her daughter [REDACTED] was standing at the door and [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if he could talk with her mother for a moment. [REDACTED] reported her daughter [REDACTED] gets concerned when Mr. Morales is alone with her. [REDACTED] reported her daughter went upstairs.

[REDACTED] reported she was out back by the pool area with Mr. Morales. [REDACTED] reported the conversation started out alright as they were talking about Christmas presents. Mr. Morales then took steps towards [REDACTED] she moved back. Mr. Morales moved again at [REDACTED] and tried to kiss her. Mrs. Morales told Mr. Morales "No, we are not doing this". [REDACTED] reported Mr. Morales grabbed her and threw her to the ground causing her to hit the back of her head. [REDACTED] reported that she wrestled and fought with Mr. Morales on the ground for about 1 to 2 minutes outside.

[REDACTED] reported Mr. Morales brought her into the basement of the residence and put her on the bed. [REDACTED] told Mr. Morales that she wanted to go. Mr. Morales told [REDACTED] "No your mine, you'll always be mine". [REDACTED] reported she threatened to call the police on him. Mr. Morales told her "I'll get out in six hours and kill you". [REDACTED] reported that while Mr. Morales had her on the bed that he slapped her, strangled her and punched her in the face. [REDACTED] reported she was on her side crying and that at this time Mr. Morales hit her with a pool stick on her left knee area. [REDACTED] reported that it hurt bad when he hit her. I asked [REDACTED] how long the assault in the basement went on for [REDACTED] reported 5 to 7 minutes.

Mr. Morales told [REDACTED] that he was taking the children and that he would bring them back on Tuesday. Mr. Morales reportedly got up and walked outside, ending the assault of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reportedly took the children to a job hanging blind. [REDACTED] did not know this location. [REDACTED]

reported she drove to her friend [REDACTED]'s house and told her about the assault.

I requested permission to photograph [REDACTED]'s injuries. I photographed bruising around her left eye, bruising around her right temple area, a swollen lip, red marks on her neck consistent with being strangled and her left knee. [REDACTED] also complained of a bump on the back of her head but due to her hair I could not observe the injury. [REDACTED] also complained of tenderness of the right shoulder. All images will be logged into evidence and copied into the detective photo folder.

I read [REDACTED] her 209A rights from a Winchester Police Department rights sheet. [REDACTED] was provided with this rights sheet. [REDACTED] was not interested in an emergency restraining order and had not decided on getting a restraining order. I provided [REDACTED] with my business card and advised her that an advocate would be reaching out to her. [REDACTED] was transported back to Woburn by Det. Lt. McManus while I followed.

On 12/13/21 while assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division, I canvassed the 300 block of [REDACTED] looking for Ring or similar type of home surveillance cameras that point towards [REDACTED] at the request of Detective Captain Murphy. The purpose of the request is in relation to the arrest of Tomas Morales for Domestic Assault and Battery. I was looking for video of the vehicle that Mr. Morales was operating at the time; a black, Dodge Ram pick up truck during the time frame of 1145 AM- 1334 hrs. I located cameras at the following addresses on Russell St. #321, 338, and 356.

I met with the resident of [REDACTED] St., identified as Mr. [REDACTED]. I explained to Mr. [REDACTED] that I was investigating an incident that occurred on Sunday, 12/12/21 and requested if I could look at his surveillance video history. Mr. [REDACTED] agreed and attempted to locate the video from the stated time frame, however, he was unsuccessful in his attempt. Mr. [REDACTED] asked his wife, however, she did not know how to access the video either. I thanked them for their time and departed their residence.

I left my contact information in the mail boxes of #'s [REDACTED].

On 3/14/21 I spoke with the resident of [REDACTED] St., identified as Mr. [REDACTED]. I explained to Mr. [REDACTED] that I was investigating an incident that occurred on Sunday, 12/12/21 and requested if I could look at his surveillance video history. Mr. [REDACTED] informed me that his system does not archive historical video.

On 12/16/21 I spoke to Ms. [REDACTED]. I explained to Ms. [REDACTED] that I was investigating an incident that occurred on Sunday, 12/12/21 and requested if I could look at her surveillance video history. Ms. [REDACTED] forwarded my contact info to her husband who had access to the system.

On the evening of 12/16/21 I received a message from Mr. [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] husband, stating that his system does not save the video as he has the free version of the on line video surveillance system.

On December 15, 2021 I, Detective James Flynn, received [REDACTED] security video surveillance footage for December 12, 2021 from Student Resource Officer Joseph Wells. SRO Wells informed me that he confirmed the date and time stamps were correct on the video. The provided video was copied into the detective photo folder.

I observed the footage which has two files called interior and exterior. I observed the interior surveillance video footage from 12/12/21. This clip shows the area outside of the gym where [REDACTED] had a basketball game. I observed Tomas Morales arrive with his daughter at 10:36:57 hours and enter the gym. I observed [REDACTED] arrive on the camera at 10:55:51 hours. The system allows for zooming and [REDACTED] shows no signs of facial injury. The basketball game ends at 11:58 hours and Mr. Morales is observed in the hall outside of the gym at 12:00:18 hours. [REDACTED] is observed in the hall outside the gym at 12:01 hours. They all go out of view heading towards the exit doors.

I observed the exterior footage from [REDACTED]. This file has three different camera angles of the front of the school. I observed Mr. Morales pull up in the black Ram rental truck bearing NY license plates and drop his son off near the entrance. Mr. Morales then drives further down the parking lot and backs the truck into a parking spot. Mr. Morales remains in the truck for some time with his daughter apparently waiting for the on going basketball game to finish before going in. I observed parents from the previous game exiting the school. At this time Mr. Morales and his daughter exit the truck and head into the school.

I observed [REDACTED] arrive in her white SUV by herself and enter the school. Upon completion of the game Mr. Morales and [REDACTED] can be seen standing outside on the sidewalk near each other at approximately 12:05 hours. The children and another woman are present. After a short time [REDACTED] heads to her white SUV alone and leaves the parking lot. Mr. Morales heads to the black Ram pick up with his children. He can be seen talking with an unknown person near the truck. Mr. Morales leaves the parking lot at 12:09 hours. This is consistent with the report filed by [REDACTED] other than her timing was off by approximately 20 minutes.

Comcast reported that based on the information provided pursuant to the Preservation, Comcast has no information responsive to the request. On December 12, 2021 I applied for and was granted an arrest warrant for Tomas Morales (2153CR001885). Mr. Morales was arrested and transported to the Woburn Police Station. See WPD report 21-615-AR. While at the Woburn Police Station, Mr. Morales was asked if he would like to speak with the investigators. Mr. Morales agreed to speak and was brought into the electronically recorded interview room.

Tomas Morales was advised of his Miranda Rights by Det. Capt. John Murphy. I, Detective James Flynn watched the recorded interview live from my desk computer. Det. Capt. Murphy read Mr. Morales his rights from a Woburn Police Department Miranda Rights sheet. Mr. Morales answered "yes" to the question "Do you understand each of these rights as I have just read to you". Mr. Morales also answered "yes" to the question "Having these rights in mind do you wish to speak with me now". Mr. Morales initialed and signed the Miranda Rights Form in the appropriate locations. Det. Capt. John Murphy signed the form as the witness. A copy of the form will be logged into evidence and scanned into the detective photo folder.

This is a brief summation of the recorded interview of Tomas Morales. See the recorded interview for its entirety. Mr. Morales was asked about his location and how he was with today. Mr. Morales reported he took his son to his basketball game at the [REDACTED]. Mr. Morales reported he went to his buddies house in Dorchester to hang window blinds. Mr. Morales was asked if he went to [REDACTED]. Mr. Morales stated he did go to the house to grab shades that he needed for the job in Dorchester. Mr. Morales was asked how long he was at the residence on [REDACTED]. Mr. Morales stated "20 minutes". Mr. Morales stated "I hate her guts, she's a prostitute". Det. Capt. Murphy attempted to ask another question but Mr. Morales told him he answered those and to watch the tape. The interview was ended and Mr. Morales was returned to the booking room.

On December 12, 2021 Officer Michael Pacheco filed a 51A report with DCF over the telephone. Officer Pacheco also faxed the report to DCF on this date.

On December 13, 2021 I, Detective James Flynn, contacted [REDACTED]. I requested she come to the Woburn Police Station for an interview regarding [REDACTED] coming to her yesterday. [REDACTED] agreed to come to the police station for an interview.

At approximately 10:40 hours [REDACTED] arrived at the police station and I brought her into the electronically recorded interview room. I advised [REDACTED] that the room was electronically recorded. I asked [REDACTED] to identify herself for the interview. This is a brief summation of the recorded interview with [REDACTED]. See recording for its entirety.

Ms. [REDACTED] reported the yesterday she was home with her two children who are currently sick. Ms. [REDACTED] reported she saw a white vehicle pull up in front of her house and her door open. Ms. [REDACTED] went to the door and came in contact with [REDACTED]. Ms. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] came in the house crying and looking all disheveled. [REDACTED] had leaves in her hair, blood coming from her lip and her eye was swelling up. [REDACTED] reportedly fell to the floor. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] stated to her "He just beat the shit out of me". I asked Ms. [REDACTED] if she could clarify to me who "he" was that [REDACTED] was stating. Ms. [REDACTED] stated "Tom Morales".

Ms. [REDACTED] gave a brief marital and the separation history of [REDACTED]. I asked Ms. [REDACTED] if she could recall the approximate time that [REDACTED] showed up at her house. Ms. [REDACTED] believed it was around 2 PM.

Ms. [REDACTED] reported the [REDACTED] told her that she was talking with Mr. Morales about Christmas and gifts. Mr. Morales asked Mrs. [REDACTED] and was told no by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told Ms. [REDACTED] that Mr. Morales stated to her that "Your mine, I'm not letting you go. We will always be together." Ms. [REDACTED] said that Mr. Morales reportedly wouldn't take no for an answer. Ms. [REDACTED] reported they were outside and then in the house. [REDACTED] told Ms. [REDACTED] that Mr. Morales had a pool stick over her throat and that Mr. Morales broke the pool stick over her knee. [REDACTED] Ms. [REDACTED] stated that the kids were in the house during the incident.

Ms. [REDACTED] reported that she took [REDACTED] for a ride in Ms. [REDACTED]'s vehicle. The two were riding around for approximately 20 minutes. Ms. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that "He is going to kill you. I can't have that on my shoulders. You need to tell someone else". [REDACTED] reportedly texted Michael Pacheco. [REDACTED] drove [REDACTED] to Mr. Pacheco's residence where she told Mr. Pacheco about Mr. Morales beating her up. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] was asked if she wanted to go to the police station. [REDACTED] stated "He is just going to get out and kill me. What do I have to live for any way."

[REDACTED] asked Ms. [REDACTED] to bring her to her sister-in-law house in Woburn which she did. Ms. [REDACTED] returned home and eventually [REDACTED] returned to pick up her vehicle. Ms. [REDACTED] then contacted Det. Lt. McManus to tell him about what had happened to [REDACTED]. I asked Ms. [REDACTED]

if [REDACTED] was in fear when they were together. Ms. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] was scared and a mess.

A copy of the recorded interview will be logged into evidence and is stored on the department's electronically recorded interview room program.

On December 13, 2021 [REDACTED] forwarded a text message she received from [REDACTED]. The text string between [REDACTED] and Ms. [REDACTED] is communication on how [REDACTED] is doing and how her face is doing. [REDACTED] communicates that she can't file a police report and that she is just going to say she fell. [REDACTED] writes she just wants the whole thing dropped and doesn't want Tom arrested. Mrs. [REDACTED] writes asking if the kids said anything about her face. [REDACTED] responds with, I told them that Tom did it to me. The text string was copied into the detective photo folder. See the text string for its entirety.

On December 13, 2021 Officer Michael Pacheco forwarded text communications between himself and [REDACTED] to my phone. Mr. Pacheco also sent me Ring surveillance footage from 12/12/21 from his house. Officer Pacheco informed me that the Ring footage shows the arrival and departure of [REDACTED] at his residence after the assault. I observed the Ring footage which shows a white SUV arrive and Officer Pacheco go outside and speak with Mrs. Morales on the passenger side of the vehicle at 13:48 hours. The second clip shows the same vehicle backing down the street to depart the area. The Ring footage provided by Officer Pacheco was copied into the detective photo folder.

The text string provided by Officer Pacheco contains the text from 12/12/21 showing Sunday 13:44. The text message shows [REDACTED] writing "hi" and Mr. Pacheco responds "hello". [REDACTED] asks "are you home" and "can I swing by". Officer Pacheco responds "yes" and "sure". This text message coincides with the Ring footage provided by Officer Pacheco which shows [REDACTED] and Ms. [REDACTED] arriving on 12/12/21 at 13:48 hours. At 16:23 hours [REDACTED] writes "Mike you get that Tom can't find out about this from anyone until the kids are safe and not with him".

The other texts provided by Officer Pacheco are later in the night of 12/12/21 into the morning of 12/13/21 after [REDACTED] made her report to me. The following are some comments written by [REDACTED] to Officer Pacheco in the text string provided. See the text string for its entirety. [REDACTED] writes; "He will forever hate me", "Even if he goes to jail he will get out and want to kill me", "I forever live in fear for this decision", "I better get my will in place for my kids and life insurance", "I so wish I never did any of this I should have just hid out until my face was better", "Can I change my mind and drop all charges and just have a restraining order against him". See the text string for its entirety.

All above mentioned texts and Ring video will be logged into evidence at the Woburn Police Station.

On December 14, 2021 I, Detective James Flynn, applied for and was granted search warrant docket number 2153CR00175 from Woburn District Court. The search warrant was for a search of [REDACTED] as described in Addendums A & B of the search warrant affidavit.

On December 14, 2021 at 14:33 hours search warrant docket number 2153CR00175 was served upon [REDACTED]. Upon arrival Detective Jeffrey Carreau and I approached the front door of the residence. The door was answered by [REDACTED]. I advised [REDACTED] that I had a search warrant for the property and handed her a copy of the search warrant and addendums. [REDACTED] opened the door and allowed the investigators into the residence. Present for the search at [REDACTED] were Detective Captain John Murphy, Detective James Flynn, Detective Jeffrey Carreau, Detective Mark Shaughnessy, State Police Crime Scene Sgt. Colleen Tanguay, State Police Crime Scene Trooper Brianna Byers, State Police Crime Scene Techs Julianna Moge Hooper and Christina Owens. Chief Robert Rufo of the Woburn Police Department also arrived at the residence.

During the search of the basement I located a broken pool stick/cue in the basement next to a bed in the basement. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] See State Police Evidence Submission Form 21-27111-1. State Police Crime Techs Hooper and Owens collected the grey comforter, blue fitted sheet, two pillow cases and a Red Sox blanket from the bed in the basement. The bedding was bagged and possession was turned over to me. Detective Carreau and Trooper Byers photographed evidence from the scene. Serial numbers were collected from two Xfinity surveillance cameras. One camera was on the front of the house and the second was on the back of the property under the deck pointed at the basement door. All personnel cleared from the residence at 16:26 hours.

Upon returning to the Woburn Police Station I logged the seized items into evidence. Broken pool stick/cue 21-1675-PR, Grey Comforter 21-1676-PR, Red Sox Blanket 21-1677-PR, Blue fitted sheet 21-1678-PR, Photographs 21-1679-PR, and 2 Pillow cases 21-1680-PR. The seized property was turned over to Woburn Police Lt. David Magee. The serial number for the front camera was 1603AXN028659. The serial number for the rear camera is S1710BFW008151.

On Monday, December 13, 2021, I, Detective Jeffrey Carreau was assigned to the A-shift (0800-1600 hours) for the Woburn Police Department Criminal Investigations Division. At the direction of Detective Captain John Murphy, Detective Daniel McIntyre and I were told to go canvas the area of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] for any video surveillance cameras that may exist. The reason for seeking the video surveillance was in relation to the arrest of Tomas Morales for Domestic Assault and Battery on a Family/Household Member. The victim in this incident was [REDACTED]. We were directed to look for any video surveillance that showed a black Dodge 4 door pickup truck with New York registration plates which was being operated by Mr. Morales on Sunday 12/12/21 between 1145 and 1345 hours in the area. I was also told to try to locate any video which showed [REDACTED] in the area between the same hours mentioned above.

I was aware that [REDACTED] had gone to her friend [REDACTED]'s residence at [REDACTED] on Sunday 12/12/21 after the alleged assault and battery took place at her residence of [REDACTED] St. I went to Dix Road where I observed video exterior video cameras mounted on the residence of [REDACTED]. There were the only cameras I observed on [REDACTED] in the area of Ms. [REDACTED] residence. I knocked rang the doorbell and knocked on the door of [REDACTED] but it went unanswered. I left a department issued notification door hanging card on the front door requesting the resident contact me. I then went to the residence at [REDACTED] Street which is at the corner of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] St where I observed exterior video cameras. I spoke with the resident about the video cameras. I was able to view the surveillance system on a large screen T.V. I watched approximately 1 hour of video but I did not observe either of the vehicles I was looking for. I told the homeowner I would work on getting a better time range and I would come back on another day.

On Tuesday, 12/14/21, I was directed by Detective Captain John Murphy to assist with the execution of a search warrant at the [REDACTED] residence at [REDACTED] St. I was directed to take photos at the residence during the execution of the warrant. I arrived at the residence with Detective James Flynn. At 1433 hours we approached the front door of the residence which was opened by [REDACTED]. Det. Flynn explained that he had a search warrant and he handed her a copy. [REDACTED] opened the door and walked inside the residence giving the investigators on scene access to the residence. I began to take photos as I followed Det. Flynn down to the basement. I took numerous photos of the basement and the backyard area. All of the photos I took at the scene were later downloaded into the Detectives Pictures folder under this case number.

On 12/15/21, I returned to [REDACTED] where I was able to view the surveillance camera footage from Sunday 12/12/21. At 1:19:17pm on the video a white GMC SUV believed to be operated by [REDACTED] turns onto [REDACTED] St coming from the direction of the Morales residence. The GMC SUV then goes out of camera view. At 1:24:49pm on the video a [REDACTED] owned by [REDACTED] who resides at [REDACTED] towards [REDACTED]. At 2:18:33pm on the video Ms. [REDACTED] white Nissan SUV returns to [REDACTED]. SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE FOR PATROLMAN MICHAEL E PACHECO

On Sunday December 12, 2021 at approximately 1344 hours, I, Officer Pacheco, while off duty received a text message from [REDACTED] the wife of a co-worker, Tom Morales. [REDACTED] asked if she could come by my house and arrived short time later she arrived with a friend, [REDACTED]

When [REDACTED] exited the vehicle she was visibly shaking and crying. I asked her what was going on and she turned her head and I observed two black and blue lumps on her right temple, and swelling and bruising around her left eye. I asked if Tom did that to her and she stated he did. I asked her to tell me what led up to the assault, [REDACTED] stated that Tom came over to the house to get the kids and that he was going to take them to his friend's house while he installed blinds at his house. She went on to state that Tom attempted to hug her [REDACTED] but she told him no, that they weren't together. She stated that this angered Tom and he made the statement, Fuck that you belong to me, and that he knows she went away the other night; [REDACTED] believes that he thinks that she was with another man. [REDACTED] then said to him that she just wanted the kids and for him to leave her alone and go with his girlfriend. This angered Tom even more and [REDACTED] stated that at that time they began to fight and that he hit her. I then asked if the kids saw it and she stated that they were up stairs, I asked if this was the first time he had hit her and she stated that it was not.

[REDACTED] stated that she did not want to file a report because he told her that if she did, that he would kill her and her parents. I asked if she felt the kids were safe with him and she stated that she did. She repeatedly stated that she did not want to file a police report and get him in trouble and put her and her family at risk. I asked her if she had a safe place to go and she stated that she did. I had her turn off the location services on her phone, because she was nervous that he would be able to track her, and once she was safe, we would make a plan. [REDACTED] informed me that her brother gave her a "burner phone" and that she would use that to contact me when she got to her friend's house and she was safe. At that time, she left with [REDACTED]
