Sir,

On the above date and approximate time while assigned to unit 12B, I was dispatched to area of Zully's Wine & Spirits for a disturbance. The disturbance was involving some people from a rally for President Trump. The rally was held from 10am till 12pm at the intersection of Kempton St and Rt 140. The call notes stated that people were harassing and throwing things at them. While in route to this location I was advised that there was now a fight in progress. Unit 10 Sgt. Faber and unit 15 Officer Smith arrived prior to me. Upon my arrival I spoke with a female who stated that she was the victim of an assault.

The victim identified as [REDACTED] stated that she had taken part in the Trump rally and was getting ready to leave when she observed a red vehicle pull up to the location where she was parked. [REDACTED] stated she was putting some items into the trunk of her car when the two young women drove by and began to make negative remarks about President Trump. [REDACTED] stated that she had a megaphone in her hand and hit the siren button on it and the car then stopped. [REDACTED] stated that the two females then got out of their car and came up to her and they began to argue. [REDACTED] stated that one of the women attempted to take her megaphone from her hand. [REDACTED] stated that she told the women to just leave that she did not want to have any problems.

[REDACTED] stated that the two young women continued to yell at her and then one began to assault her. [REDACTED] stated that one of the females grabbed her by the hair and began to punch her, [REDACTED] stated that she then grabbed the female by her hair. [REDACTED] stated that she was pulled to the ground by her hair causing her to scrape both knees. [REDACTED] stated that she was kicked by the second female. [REDACTED] stated that at this time two other parties that attended the Trump rally came to assist her. The two females were separated from [REDACTED] and left the scene shortly afterwards. [REDACTED] was asked if she would like medics to respond to our location but she refused and stated she would seek medical attention when she returned to her home town.

While on scene I was advised by Sgt. Faber that he had seen the suspects in the red vehicle drive by the rally location on multiple occasions. Ofc. Lawrence who was also in the area during the rally also confirmed seeing the red vehicle driving around this location. Officer Lawrence stated that at one point the vehicle stopped next to his cruiser and the females inside expressed to him their unhappiness about one of the signs being held by someone at the rally.

I then spoke to a male identified as [REDACTED] who went to assist [REDACTED] when he saw what was going on. [REDACTED] stated that he was getting into his car when he heard a commotion and looked up and saw [REDACTED] involved in a fight with two females. [REDACTED] stated that he ran over to break up the fight. [REDACTED] stated that he also recorded the incident on his cell phone. [REDACTED] stated that two young women were yelling at [REDACTED] and then began yelling at him. [REDACTED] stated that the two young women eventually got into their car and drove off. [REDACTED] stated that he stayed with [REDACTED] to make sure the two women did not return to continue the fight. I then spoke with [REDACTED] who was also with [REDACTED] at the time of the assault.

██████████ stated she was also putting some things into her vehicle when she saw the red car harassing some of her fellow Trump supporters. ██████████ stated that she also heard the argument and when she looked over she saw ██████████ being assaulted by two younger women. ██████████ stated that she helped get the two young women away from ██████████. A license plate number was obtained and given to the police. The plate ██████████ was run by communications and returned to a party at ██████████ in Temple Landing. Sgt. Faber made his way to this location to see if he could locate the vehicle and speak with the owner.

Upon his arrival Sgt Faber was able to locate the owner of the vehicle and the operator who is the owner's daughter identified as ██████████. I arrived shortly after and spoke with ██████████ in regards to the incident. ██████████ stated that she was driving with her friend, who she refused to identify when they passed the rally. ██████████ stated that she considers herself as an activist and wanted to voice her opinion to the Trump supporters. ██████████ stated that she drove into the parking lot to use the ATM (Bank of America) when she saw the victim and other supporters. ██████████ stated that she drove up and made some negative comments about the president when the group approached her vehicle. ██████████ stated that she became scared due to them surrounding her car. ██████████ stated that the woman who was holding the megaphone came up to her and began blaring the siren at her.

██████████ stated that she has video that she took with her cell phone showing how the incident unfolded. ██████████ stated that the female came up to her car while holding a megaphone in her face with the alarm sound blasting. ██████████ stated that she began to warn this woman to back away from her car but she would not. ██████████ stated that after a couple times warning her she got out of her car. ██████████ stated that she and this woman continued to argue and then another person approached and began to argue with ██████████ and her friend. ██████████ stated that the woman (██████████) became aggressive and got into her personal space. ██████████ stated that she again warned the woman to back away and get out of her face. ██████████ stated that the fight began after ██████████ pushed her.

On 10/13/20 ██████████ called me at station 1 requesting to come in because she wanted to pursue charges because she was assaulted by ██████████ first. ██████████ stated that she was pushed by ██████████ with the megaphone she was holding. ██████████ also stated that the male who was there assisting ██████████ assaulted her while breaking up the fight. ██████████ stated that the male (██████████) hit her in the neck area and grabbed her by her hooded sweatshirt yanking it around her neck. ██████████ stated that her neck is soar and that she woke up this morning and vomited blood. ██████████ came into station 1 and presented the video which depicts the argument and fight between the involved parties. The video showed the two women stopped in the parking lot and yelling out the window at the Trump rally attendants.

At one point you can see ██████████ approach the vehicle with the megaphone in her hand and the siren sound blasting. The three women are then seen and heard arguing which leads to the two women then are seen getting out of the car and the arguing turns to a fight where ██████████ is dragged to the ground by her hair by the unidentified female. The fight is then broken up by other bystander's that were in the parking lot. ██████████ stated that she realizes that the whole incident was foolish and should never have happened.

██████████ also stated that she is very ashamed and embarrassed by her behavior. ██████████ was given a civilian statement form to be filled out and that form will be attached to this report. Lt. Bielski was able to obtain a copy of the video taken by ██████████ from an online post, and burned it to a CD to be entered as evidence along with the video from ██████████'S phone.

After watching videos posted to online social media sites and viewing the video from ██████████'S cell phone it is clear to see in video evidence all individuals involved are causing a disturbance in a public parking lot and using vulgar language, slur words, and creating a disruptive and agitated environment. Video evidence also shows the individuals involved antagonizing each other with words and vulgar gestures with all parties engaging in behavior in attempts to cause a fight. Eventually the behavior of all involved led to a physical altercation occurring. Please refer to video evidence for full extent of the tumultuous behavior that was displayed by all. There are other parties seen on video attempting to quell the situation and be the voice of reason. ██████████ is one of the parties who recorded the incident and is heard at the beginning of his video yelling (**triggered triggered**) and yelling profanities at the two younger women. At one point you can hear ██████████ antagonizing the two younger women yelling at them to "**hit me hit me**". There is also an unidentified party who is seen and heard on the video telling ██████████ to stop antagonizing the two females. ██████████ is heard arguing with this male and continuing to carry on with this behavior.

On 10/14/20 I was advised by Lt. Bielski that he had received feedback regarding the identity of the female who was with ██████████. This female was identified as possibly being a ██████████ but we were advised she has a twin sister named ██████████. After further investigating Lt. Bielski found a Facebook post by ██████████ titled "**my sister's a dog**" followed by the video of the incident involving the listed parties. There is a picture of the Facebook post and it is attached to this report. Three of the four parties involved were advised that a hearing will be requested and they would be summons to court at a future date. I was not able to contact ██████████ we do not have any current phone numbers in our local system and ██████████ is still refusing to give her information. **NOTE: Please refer to video evidence for full details of incident**
